The 15th Jan Tinbergen European Peace Science Conference will be held at the Department of Politics and International Studies at the University of Warwick, on 22nd - 24th June 2015. The Jan Tinbergen Conference is interdisciplinary and welcomes presentations that address any issue relating to peace and security broadly defined. It strives for a multi-disciplinary program comprising contributions with a wide range of theoretical and methodological approaches, including strictly theoretical work, game theory and formal modeling, statistical and econometric analysis, qualitative studies, and experiments. Abstracts (150-250 words) with a tentative title submitted before 8th February 2015 will be considered for the conference.
